& THE CHOLO CHERUB**



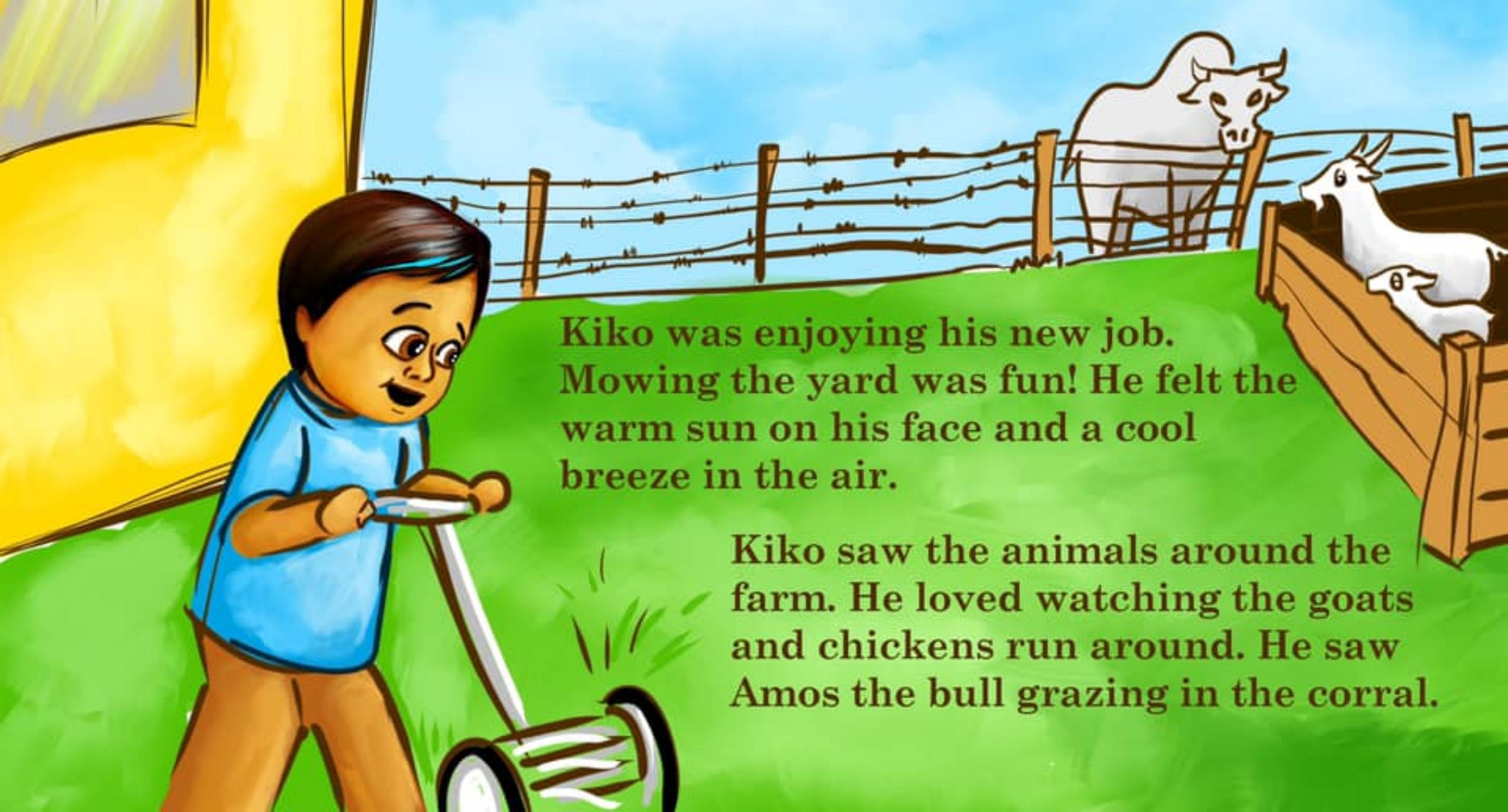
Today is an exciting day for Kiko. Grandmother is letting him mow the lawn! He has always loved Grandmother's old reel mower, and finally he gets to use it.

Kiko said, looking down.



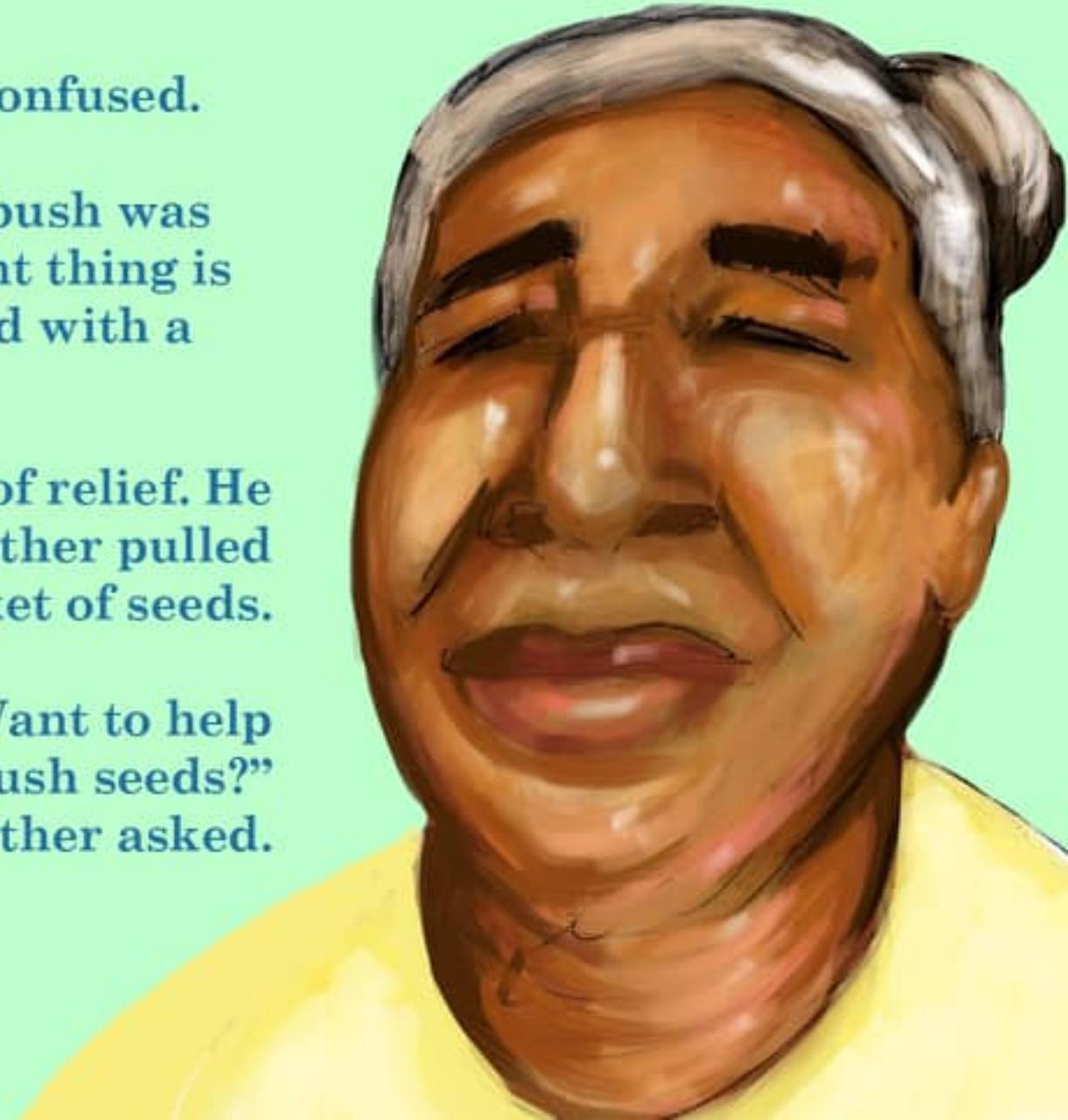
Grandmother thought for a moment. “Thank you for telling me,” she said at last.
